Motion was made by Lansing and seconded by Wheeler to approve the cost for lighting the water tank for Christmas to be paid out of water.

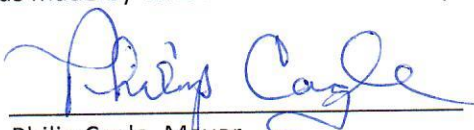
