A copy of the previous minutes was given to each member of the board and after reviewing; motion to approve as distributed was made by Lansing and seconded by Wheeler.

Jeff Henry representing “Let’s Light Up Pikeville for The Holidays” organization explained to the board their plans for lighting up Pikeville from the North end to the South end of Main Street. They are accepting donations of gently used lights, wreaths, trees, or other decorations as well as monetary donations. Activities such as, Christmas Tree Lighting Ceremony with entertainment the night of the parade. Musical Entertainment during December, Christmas Pageant, Evening shopping by merchants and Farmer’s Market, Carriage & Wagon Rides, Photos Booth with Santa, Sunday Afternoon Tea Party, etc.

He also explained that he had met with Nooga Lights about lighting the buildings downtown from Column to column and they had given them a price of \$10,000 dollars. The price would include installing, maintenance on the bulbs, and taking them down.

The board discussed some dollar amounts to give to the project and after discussing; Motion was made by Humble to give \$5,000.00. Wheeler asked could we give more?

After Humbles motion it was suggested that since it was downtown to pay the \$10,000 amount.

Motion was made by Lansing and seconded by Wheeler to amend Humbles motion from \$5,000 to \$10,000.

Motion was made by Anderson and seconded by Humble to approve moving \$833.06 of utility debt from active status to inactive status for collection and also approve the utility adjustments.

Vote – Anderson – YES, Humble – YES, Lansing – YES, Wheeler – YES


In other business:
