Paul Swafford, Fire Chief informed the board they received three statements of qualifications from Engineering Firms on the Fire Hall Addition. He also said that, they have been talking with USDA and SETDD about applying for a grant and the deadline is Friday 19th, 2022 to apply.

The question was asked by Lansing how much money did the city have to put on the Fire Hall and do we have a plan B if we do not get the grant. The board was informed there is \$175,000 that could be used for the addition and maybe look at a local contractor for a metal type addition for plan B.

Chief Swafford was informed to go ahead and apply for the grant and to make sure the contractor they choose understood that, there would be no cost to the city if they did not get the grant. If we do not get the grant then we will discuss a plan B.

The mayor informed the board that, Dunlap Stone Inc. had turned their bid in for paving Main Street from Sells Bldg. to the by-pass for \$325,000 and all work to be financed by the contractor, at 0.00% interest. Mayor also said that, if we did this, he would like for it to be paid off in three years.

Motion was made by Anderson and seconded by Lansing to approve Dunlap Stone Bid of \$325,000 for paving Main Street from Sells Bldg. Supply to the By-Pass and to accept the financing offer of 0.00% interest.
