A copy of the previous minutes was given to each member of the board and after reviewing; motion to approve as distributed was made by Anderson and seconded by Lansing.

The mayor informed the board that bids were solicited for an 80 X 80 concrete pad for the fire hall. It is to be 8 inches thick with rebar. Each step of the fire hall addition would be subcontracted, with a budget of \$175,000 dollars. It was once again mentioned by all the board the importance of getting the ladder fire truck housed back in the city.

The bid results: 1. Kane Industries, LLC --- \$98,781.00  
2. B2 Construction, LLC --- \$75,000.00

Motion was made by Lansing and seconded by Humble to approve the low bidder for the 80 X 80 pad.

In other business:


\*Police Service call report for Jan – Mar was presented.
