Motion was made by Anderson and seconded by Humble to adopt the above said resolution.

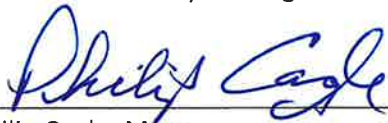
