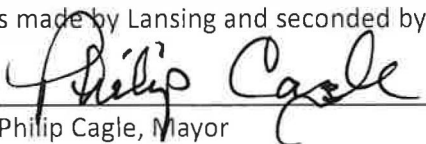
In other business:
