**Pikeville, Tennessee** – On April 16, 2025, officers with the Pikeville Police Department responded to a call regarding a physical disturbance that had occurred at Pikeville City Park, located at 2411 Main Street. The caller reported that a fight had broken out involving several adults and juveniles, with a video of the incident circulating on social media.

After a thorough investigation, all parties involved in the altercation were identified. The incident stemmed from comments made in a group chat on the Snap Chat app, leading to an agreement to meet at the park to settle their differences. Upon arrival, the situation escalated into a physical confrontation.

The Pikeville Police Department has charged Brayden Hatfield, Pablo Jose Rivas, Jazmine Raber, Michael Jaydon McBay, Alexa Marie Dodson, and Anthony Du Shan Carey with one count of Disorderly Conduct each. Additionally, four juveniles have received Juvenile Petitions to appear in Bledsoe County Juvenile Court for Delinquent Child Disorderly Conduct charges.

It is important to note that such behavior will not be tolerated in the City of Pikeville. The Pikeville Police Department appreciates the assistance of community members in the investigation.
