A copy of the previous minutes was given to each member of the board and after reviewing; motion to approve as distributed was made by Anderson and seconded by Lansing.

Motion to approve moving \$900.38 of utility debt from active status to inactive status for collection and also approve the utility adjustments was made by Wheeler and seconded by Lansing.

Mayor Cagle explained to the board that our long time Engineer Robert Stigall had merged with Hussey, Gaybell, Engineering Firm based out of South Carolina. Robert has retired and there has been nothing but problems with the engineering firm on the new wastewater treatment plant. Problems mentioned were, saying everything was in order to start the project which caused problems with SRF funding, inconsistency with pay apps, necessary paper work not being completed on time. SRF come to the point of telling TAUD they would have to help straighten out the pay apps. TAUD came in and worked on the pay apps and found several inconsistencies.

Mayor Cagle then said that, it was recommended that the city consult with a third-party professional to oversee everything moving forward. He said that, Jacobs Engineering Group INC. out of Chattanooga, TN had been highly recommended by all Agencies involved in the project.

The mayor recommended going with the Master Professional Service Agreement with Jacobs Engineering Group INC to oversee the Wastewater Treatment Plant moving forward.

Motion was made by Lansing and seconded by Anderson to approve the Service Agreement with Jacobs Engineering Group.
